GENERAL RULES (Revised 8/16)

- 1. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Maximum time for each recital will be approximately 60 minutes. Specific scheduling needs should be communicated to the teacher at the time of application. Each studio may enter up to 5 students, plus 1 alternate, with a limit of 2 pieces (per instrument) per student. Combined performance time should not exceed 12 minutes per studio. The application fee for each student participant, accompanists excepted, is \$5.00 and must be sent with each application form. Make checks payable to MTAC-SCC.
- 2. Use a separate application form for each student entered. Please write clearly and spell correctly student name, composer, piece, and its approximate performance time. Information on the student's age and proficiency or CM level are also important. Should a student be unable to perform, please contact me ASAP so I can adjust the program, laureensherr@gmail.com

January 29, 2017, Sunday - 2:30 pm, Santa Cruz Public Library, 224 Church St, Central Branch (Upstairs meeting room)

Students are to arrive at 2:00 pm. Recital preparation will take place at that time and the performance will begin at 2:30 pm. Parking is limited, but your student can be dropped off ahead for the half hour preparation. Teachers will be present on the premises at 2:00 PM.

DRESS STANDARDS

Not appropriate:

T-shirts, shorts, athletic team jerseys, jeans, bare midriffs, exposed underwear, form fitting camisoles or tank tops, sloppy slide-on shoes including flip-flops.

We reserve the right to ask inappropriately dressed students not to perform.

Preferred Dress:

ALL STUDENTS: Hair should be arranged so that it does not fall into the face while performing. Black concert attire is appropriate.

GIRLS:

Dresses or skirts knee length or longer, or dressy slacks. (Skirts shorter than knee length should be accompanied by tights.)

Blouses or shirts completely covering midriff when performing.

Dress shoes (no athletic shoes or flip-flops)

Pianists: Try out shoes with piano pedals beforehand.

BOYS:

Collared dress shirt, dress slacks and nice shoes. Coat and tie welcome.

No athletic shoes or flip-flops.

CONCERT ETIQUETTE:

- Plan to arrive a little early allow more than enough time to find parking.
- Sit quietly while others perform.
- Performers should acknowledge the audience's applause with a bow and smile before and after performing.
- PLAN TO STAY FOR THE ENTIRE RECITAL. If you must leave early, sit near the exit and leave between performers.
- Parents, be prepared to take noisy younger siblings outside.
